## The 2024 5th Grade Summer Math Challenge

Welcome to 5th Grade Math. This year our class is using a program called Boddle to improve students' fundamental skills in Math. Throughout the year I'll be using Boddle to assign tasks, track progress, and support your child's learning. This summer your child will use Boddle to complete 6 assignments that enable them to practice, review and master essential math skills.

Each of the 6 lessons is specifically designed to target the skills your child needs to begin the year with confidence. It is important that your child complete **all** six assignments before the school year begins. This provides me with important data to identify your child's strengths and weaknesses and cultivate lessons that can specifically meet your child's needs.

Once you log in to **The Brook Hill 5th Grade Classroom**, I will be able to track your child's progress. All six assignments "unlock" on May 23. Your child has until September 1 to complete all assignments. Your child can play as often as they want and repeat assignments several times. Each time they play, they accumulate points. On September 2nd, the top three scores from each homeroom will receive a special prize! So let the challenge begin! See you in August!

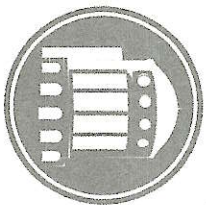
### **How to access the 5th Grade Summer Challenge:**

#### **Signing in on a computer, laptop, or chromebook**

1. Go to play.boddlelearning.com
2. Log in or Create an account to Boddle. Use password: **GUARD24**
3. In the game click on "Add Course"
4. Type in the class code: **z4r1g5**

#### **Signing in on a smartphone or tablet**

1. Download the Boddle iOS/Android app (Search 'Boddle')
2. Log in or Create an account to Boddle. Use password: **GUARD24**
3. In the game click on "Add Course"
4. Type in the class code: **z4r1g5**

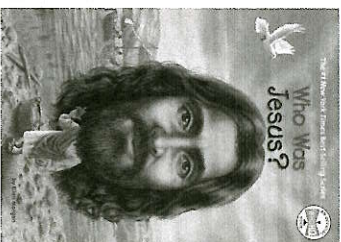


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## Entering Fifth Grade Summer Assignment **\* Due the First Day of School \***

2. **Purchase** a *Who Was?* paper copy of the book (example below) related to your historical American. You will need to bring your book to school, so do not buy an electronic version.

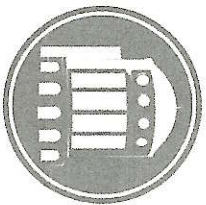


3. **Complete** a hanger person that represents your American according to the attached rubric. Your grade will be based on following each direction listed on the rubric.

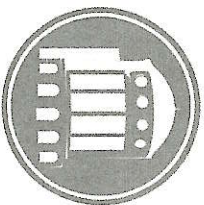

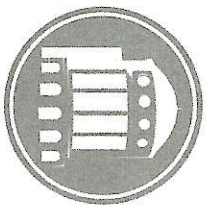
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## Hanger Person Biography Grading Rubric

This rubric has all of the requirements you will need in order to achieve a score of 4, 3, 2, or 1. To meet the requirement of the score, you must score MOSTLY in that section.

<b>4</b>	<p>"Person" accurately portrays the subject of the biography ** Clothing is accurate to the time period ** Artwork is neatly put together ** Expression is evident in the face of the hanger person ** The body is positioned in a different and unique way ** Evidence of research on the subject through the clothing, hair style, etc...</p>
<b>3</b>	<p>"Person" is a mostly accurate portrayal of the subject of the biography ** Clothing is mostly accurate to the time period ** Artwork is mostly neat and put together ** Some expression is evident in the face of the hanger person ** The body is positioned in a mostly different and unique way ** Evidence of research on the subject through the clothing, hair style, etc...</p>
<b>2</b>	<p>"Person" is a mostly accurate portrayal of the subject of the biography ** Clothing is somewhat accurate to the time period ** Artwork is somewhat neat and put together ** Some expression is evident in the face of the hanger person ** The body is positioned in a somewhat different and unique way ** Some evidence of research on the subject through the clothing, hair style, etc...</p>
