Middle & Upper School (6th-12th) Dress Code The Brook Hill School 2024-2025

*Please note that only Land's End and Academy Uniforms brands are "BH approved".

The administration reserves the right to determine if a student is dressed and groomed appropriately and may ask the student to make changes if they deem it necessary. It is required that all uniforms be purchased from Land's End or Academy Uniforms brand clothing. Students are expected to adhere to the dress code while officially representing Brook Hill.

Girls' Daily Attire (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday)

- o Khaki, navy, or plaid uniform skirt/skort; khaki or navy uniform pants/shorts; navy polo dress
- Navy or white uniform polo shirt
- Closed-toe shoes (no house shoes or crocs)

Boys' Daily Attire (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday)

- Khaki or navy uniform pants/shorts-(a button and zipper)
- Navy or white uniform polo shirt (tucked in)
- o Brown, black, or navy belt must be worn
- Closed-toe shoes (no house shoes or crocs)

Girls' Chapel Attire

- o Khaki, navy, or plaid uniform skirt
- White uniform blouse (tucked in)
- Solid white or navy socks
- Closed-toe shoes (no house shoes or crocs)
- BH sweater, sweater vest, navy cardigan, quarter-zip or navy/gray jacket may be worn with uniform blouse.
- O No hoodies or sweatshirts may be worn on Chapel day.

Boys' Chapel Attire

- Navy or khaki uniform pants
- Uniform white oxford shirt (tucked in)
- o BH uniform tie
- Solid white or navy socks
- o Brown, black, or navy belt
- Closed-toe shoes (no house shoes or crocs)
- o BH sweater, sweater vest, navy cardigan, quarter-zips or navy/ gray jacket may be worn with uniform oxford shirt.
- No hoodies or sweatshirts may be worn on Chapel day.

Girls' Friday Dress:

- o Jeans, uniform pants, uniform shorts, or uniform skirts
- o BH t-shirts/spirit shirts or uniform polo shirt
- Closed-toe shoes
- o NOT ALLOWED:
 - Inappropriately tight jeans
 - Jeggings /Leggings
 - Joggers
 - Sweat pants
 - Athletic shorts
 - Jeans with holes
 - Tennis skirts

Boys' Friday Dress

- Jeans, uniform pants, uniform shorts
- o BH t-shirts/spirit shirts or uniform polo shirt
- Closed-toe shoes
- O NOT ALLOWED:
 - Inappropriately tight jeans
 - Joggers
 - Sweat pants
 - Athletic shorts
 - Jeans with holes
 - Golf pants

Dress Code Guidelines for Girls:

- o Only BH outerwear (jackets, sweatshirts, hoodies, quarter-zips) is allowed.
- o Khaki color MUST match the Land's End and Academy Uniform khaki.
- o Pants, shorts, and skirts must be worn above or at the hips.
- Shorts and skirts must be mid-thigh or longer in length.
- o Appropriate undergarments and modesty shorts are to be worn under skirts at all times.
- No sandals, flip-flops, Crocs, moccasin-type footwear, shoes with wheels, house shoes/slippers, or UGGS (this includes slides) may be worn at any time.
- Warm-ups, skinny jeans, jeggings, joggers, leggings, and pajama pants are not acceptable.
- o Leggings (solid white or solid navy) may be worn under uniform skirt only.
- o Polo shirts may be worn tucked in or left out.
- Only solid white t-shirts or tanks (without writing) may be worn under white uniform shirts or chapel blouse.
- Hats may not be worn during the school day.

Dress Code Guidelines for Boys:

- Only BH outerwear (jackets, sweatshirts, hoodies, quarter-zips) is allowed.
- o Khaki color MUST match the Land's End and Academy Uniform khaki.
- Pants and shorts must be worn above or at the hips.
- Shorts must be mid-thigh or longer in length.
- No sandals, flip-flops, Crocs, moccasin-type footwear, shoes with wheels, house shoes/slippers, or UGGS (this includes slides) may be worn at any time.
- Shirts must be tucked into pants or shorts, except when wearing Friday dress.
- o Belts (black, brown, or navy) must be worn, except when wearing Friday dress.
- Only solid white t-shirts (without writing) may be worn under white uniform shirts.
- Hats may not be worn during the school day.

Additional Guidelines for Girls:

- o Abnormal or extreme hairstyles as determined by the administration are not permitted.
- At all before school and after school Brook Hill events (sporting events, fine arts events, etc.),
 students do not need to be in uniform but must follow similar guidelines.
- Students may be asked to cover tattoos if they are visible.
- Highlighting and coloring of hair is permitted as long as it is dyed a natural color.
- Jewelry should be modest with no oversized earrings and necklaces and should not draw attention to self. No piercing other than ears.
- Appropriate attire is expected at all Brook Hill dances. Specific dress guidelines will be communicated to the student body prior to the dance.

Additional Guidelines for Boys:

- No piercings are allowed. Earrings are not allowed.
- Hair may not go past the bottom of the collar or be below the middle of the ears and must be trimmed at or above the eyebrows. Hair may be tied up with a hair tie in order to meet these requirements.
- No facial hair is permitted. Students must be clean shaven at all times. Sideburns may not extend below the earlobe.
- Abnormal or extreme hairstyles as determined by the administration are not permitted.
- At all Brook Hill events (sporting events, fine arts events, etc.), student do not need to be in uniform but must follow similar guidelines.
- Students may be asked to cover tattoos if they are visible.
- Highlighting and coloring of hair is permitted as long as it is dyed a natural color.
- Appropriate attire is expected at all Brook Hill dances. Specific dress guidelines will be communicated to the student body prior to the dance.
